The book is a memoir, but it shares more than merely family memories of significant events. It tells of beliefs, home remedies, folk games, and customs, as well as the importance of religion and education to a community of like-minded people. The narrative is a rich source of colloquial language and proverbial sayings that help define a group of people and their strong sense of place. Richard Orton was first introduced to County Line by F. E. "Ab" Abernethy, the Secretary-Editor of the TFS for nearly four decades. Richard eventually did a photographic book on the people of the community, *The Upshaws of County Line: An American Family*, but he believed that Beatrice's memoir should be developed into a separate work that could be shared with an audience larger than just family and friends. Richard's introduction explains the value of the stories Beatrice Upshaw presents in *A Biscuit for Your Shoe*; they are personal, but the overall narrative speaks collectively about the perseverance and innovation of many

people who found a way to not only survive, but to thrive in East Texas.
