The Hand, an Organ of the Mind May 10 2021 Theoretical and empirical accounts of the interconnectedness between the motor and the mental suggest that the hand can be understood as a cognitive instrument. Cartesian-inspired dualism enforces a

theoretical distinction between the motor and the cognitive and locates the mental exclusively in the head. This collection, focused on the hand, challenges this dichotomy, offering theoretical and empirical perspectives on the interconnectedness and interdependence of the manual and mental. The contributors explore the possibility that the hand, far from being the merely mechanical executor of preconceived mental plans, possesses its own knowledge enabling "enhanded" beings to navigate the natural, social, and cultural world without engaging propositional thought, consciousness, and deliberation. Wherever the Sound Takes You Jun 30 2020 David Rowell is a professional journalist and an impassioned amateur musician. He spent decades behind a drum kit, pondering the musical relationship between equipment and emotion. In *Wherever the Sound Takes You*, he explores the essence of music's meaning with a vast spectrum of players, trying to understand their connection to their chosen instrument, what they've put themselves through for their music, and what they feel when they play. This wide-ranging and openhearted book blossoms outward from there.
